EQUIPMENT

LIGHTING

Use the light switches next to the board to adjust the lighting as needed.

DATA PROJECTOR

1. SETTING UP THE SCREEN

Pull the projector screen down manually to the required height.

2. OPERATING THE PROJECTOR

Press the data projector remote's **Power** button to turn the projector on / off.

Note: The projector takes 1 minute to warm up before you can use it. If it's recently been switched off, wait a few minutes before switching it on.

3. SELECTING AN INPUT

The projector can display one of these inputs:

Input	Instructions
DVD / VCR	 Do not connect your laptop to the projector. On the data projector remote, select Video. Operate the DVD-VCR player via its remote, or the controls on the DVD-VCR unit in the safe.
Laptop	 Ensure that the DVD-VCR player is off or in standby mode. On the data projector remove, select RGB / Computer. Connect your laptop to the projector.
	* Note: Only VGA laptops can be projected. HDMI laptops are not supported in this classroom.

4. CONNECTING YOUR LAPTOP TO THE DATA PROJECTOR

Visual input	Connect the VGA cable from the VGA socket on the teaching wall to your laptop's VGA output connector socket.	
	If the projection screen doesn't display your laptop screen output:	
	 Look for a Function / Fn (F1, F2, etc.) key on your laptop keyboard that represents the monitor display. 	
	2. Hold the Fn key and press the relevant monitor display key.	
Audio input	Connect the audio cable from the amplifier in the safe to your laptop's earphone jack.	
Internet / network access	Network cable: Connect the network cable from the teaching wall to your laptop's LAN socket.	
	Wireless: To use the wireless network, connect your laptop to UCT's eduroam WiFi service*.

AUDIO LEVELS

Use your laptop's built-in volume control. To adjust the speaker volume, use the **Aux 1** dial on the amplifier in the safe.

PACKING UP

- 1. If your class is the last before Meridian or at the end of the day, turn off the data projector and the DVD-VCR player.
- 2. Unplug your laptop.
- 3. Put all items back in the safe and lock the safe.
- 4. Roll up the projector screen.
- 5. Turn off the lights.
