EQUIPMENT

LIGHTING

- Board lights:** Use the **Board** switch at the door to turn these lights on/off.
- Main lights:** Use the **Main** switch at the door to turn these lights on/off.
- Blinds:** Use the **Blinds** panel next to the board to open or close the blinds automatically.

DATA PROJECTOR

1. SETTING UP THE SCREEN

Pull the projector screen down manually to your required level.

2. OPERATING THE PROJECTOR

Press the data projector remote's **Power** button once to turn the projector on.

Note: The projector may take a minute to warm up before you can use it. If it's recently been switched off, wait a few minutes before switching it on.

3. SELECTING AN INPUT

| Input | Instructions |
|---------|--|
| DVD/VCR | <ol style="list-style-type: none">Do not connect your laptop to the projector.On the data projector remote, select Video.Operate the DVD-VCR player via its remote, or the controls on the DVD-VCR unit in the safe. |
| Laptop | <ol style="list-style-type: none">Ensure that the DVD-VCR player is off / in standby mode.On the data projector remote, select Computer (if you are connecting a VGA laptop), or HDMI if you are connecting an HDMI-enabled laptop.Connect your laptop to the projector (see Connecting instructions below). |

4. CONNECTING YOUR LAPTOP TO THE DATA PROJECTOR

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|----------------------------------|--|
| Visual input | <ol style="list-style-type: none">Connect the VGA or HDMI cable to your laptop's VGA or HDMI output connector socket.Connect the other end of the cable to the VGA or HDMI socket next to the board. <p>If the display isn't immediately visible on the projector's screen, press the laptop's Fn key with the relevant F key that displays a picture of a monitor next to or above the F number (for example, F1).</p> |
| Audio input | If you're using a VGA connection, connect the loose end of the audio cable (in the safe) to your laptop's earphone jack. (HDMI connections do not require this step.) |
| Internet / network access | To use the wireless network, connect your laptop to UCT's <i>eduroam</i> WiFi service*. * Visit www.icts.uct.ac.za/wireless-at-UCT for instructions. |

AUDIO LEVELS

Use the Master dial on the amplifier in the safe.

 - The data projector
 - The DVD-VCR player
 2. Put all items back in the safe and lock the safe.
